

CURBSIDE RECYCLING EXCELS IN FIRST MONTH

In 2009 the residents of Glendale, using our former drop off center, recycled 119 tons . In July of 2010, our first month of curbside recycling, we recycled a remarkable 35.54 tons. *This one month of July represents almost one third of what was recycled in 2009!*

Below are the actual recycling percentages for the past four months. The July figures include our new curbside program and a remarkable percentage increase.

In April Glendale generated 102 tons of waste and recycled 10.05% of it.

In May Glendale generated 99 tons of waste and recycled 10.16% of it.

In June Glendale generated 106 tons of waste and recycled 13.46% of it.

In July Glendale generated 117 tons of waste and recycled 30.50% of it. *

Reducing landfill waste helps all of us through lower transportation costs to the landfill, reduction in our waste of natural resources through reuse and increased incentives from the Hamilton County Solid Waste District based on how much waste we divert to recycling.

Here is a tip to increase your recycling: Don't throw your junk mail in the trash, throw it in your recycle bin. Magazines, catalogues, mail. It can all be recycled!
