Statements Salon has been collecting cut hair for the past month for Matter of Trust, which is coordinating the efforts of thousands of participating salons and volunteers sending hair donations, as well as nylon pantyhose, to temporary warehousing along the coastline in Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana and Florida. Volunteers then build “booms” - hair stuffed into the pantyhose - from these donations. According to Matter of Trust, the 300,000 pounds of hair cut everyday in the U.S. has the capacity to clean an average of 726 million gallons of oil. ###
